The product described in your submission is information related to the design and development of amateur radio hardware for space (Amateur Radio satellites in geosynchronous orbit) and corresponding ground stations.

A technical review of your commodity jurisdiction (CJ) request has been concluded by requisite agencies of the United States government. The findings of that technical review are:

The Department of State has determined that the Information and Software for a Digital Microwave Broadband Communications System for Space and Terrestrial Amateur Radio Use is not subject to its jurisdiction.
